Parallel Session II: Future Trends and Development of Cross-border Payments

Over the past few decades, global payment systems have undergone radical transformation. Yet cross-border payments are still in many cases slow, expensive, opaque, and not easily accessible for many global users.

In October 2020, the G20 endorsed an ambitious roadmap to comprehensively tackle these challenges and make lasting improvements to cross-border payments. Against this background, BIS Innovation Hub has played a pivotal role in advancing innovation in cross-border payment, and launched several projects directly or indirectly related, including mBridge, Nexus, etc.

This close-door session intends to convene financial regulators, academia, and industry professionals to review the current development status and identify future developments and dynamics that will facilitate cross-border payment enhancements.
